100 CHURCHES RISING CHALLENGE LEARN, PREACH, GIVE, PRAY.

One of the most important things that churches and faith communities can do right now is turn to Scripture and learn what God has to say about immigrants.

We know for a fact that God is not silent on the topic of immigrants and immigration. "Ger," the Hebrew word for foreigner or immigrant, occurs 92 times in the Old Testament, and "xenos," Greek for immigrant, occurs 14 times in the New Testament! God's message is clear: we are to *love* immigrants. God's heart is *for* immigrants.

God's call throughout Scripture is particularly relevant today. We are living in a time when immigrants and immigration have become a "divisive issue", and it is even common for people of faith to completely miss the Bible's clear teaching about immigrants. It is more important than ever before that churches become firmly rooted in a foundation of Scripture so that our hearts, minds, and actions are aligned with the heart of God.

Immigrant Connection has developed a devotional guide that leads churches and congregations through key passages and biblical principles that make clear God's heart for immigrants and our call to love immigrants. The *Together at the Table* devotional guide has been specifically designed so that churches can use them to learn, be discipled, and be transformed together. Each session of the devotional guide focuses on a crucial aspect of understanding immigrants as followers of Jesus. At the end of each session are discussion and reflection questions as well as action steps.

This study is intentionally open to however you may choose to use it. Some churches incorporate them into their small group programming. Others read and discuss on a weekly basis with their leadership team. Others create a weekly or monthly gathering that involves a dinner together before entering into a time of reflection. Please use this study as it works best for your church and in your context.
